**Again novelty presentation at AERO:
sky[nav]pro™ now adds collision avoidance**

Berlin. After introducing its BlueLine Satellite Box which offers in flight weather and real time tracking and monitoring at AERO 2016 in Friedrichshafen last year, Dacher Systems is now launching its RedLine Box, containing the hardware to offer collision avoidance. Dacher is gearing up present at AERO 2017 in Hall 6, Stand 103. The upgraded Box is ADS-B capable and ready for FLARM signals. Both boxes are portable transceivers which use terrestrial and satellite based mobile data signals. Those, in turn, are processed by the navigation app on iOS and Android tablets. Besides conveniently displaying free GAFOR and weather radar imagery in real time, pilots will then have the option to have traffic displayed along the route of flight. The currently available and sold BlueLine box is available at 699.-€ with the 49,99€ data plan already including 5 hours of free weather and tracking and BlueLine box owners will be able to easily upgrade to the Redline Box.
